Business and Community Committee

The committee continues to monitor the cafeteria effectiveness. The information at this point indicates that the cafeteria is still a viable service for the division. The upgrades to the area have been well received and the Norman RHA has offered the donation of furniture and equipment for our use in the cafeteria.

Additional Items

We have received funding to support the Science Ambassador Program and the focus will be the Grade 4 classes and the middle school classes.
