The division is still in need of bus drivers. This shortage has created a need to review bussing in the division. The committee has begun a review of “in town” bussing and all the rural routes. The committee wants to provide an effective service to all the rural riders to keep their time on the bus to a minimum. They are also looking at way to provide some “in town” bussing.

The Board of Trustees passed a motion to restrict bus use to one bus for travelling from the pickup and return to the same location. The committee will be reviewing information and feedback they received to find a solution to our bussing issues.
