PARENTS ATTENDANCE AT PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT OPPORTUNITIES

In order for the parents or legal guardians of students in our schools to become more familiar with the programs, Kelsey School Division encourages parents or guardians to observe the professional development opportunities afforded to professional staff. Parents or guardians may attend the sessions, but in order that the staff of Kelsey School Division receives full benefit from these opportunities, the parents or guardians so in attendance must abide by the following:

- a) Must inform the school of their intentions to attend prior to the actual professional development day.
- b) May participate as observers only and shall not comment on, ask questions, or in any way interrupt the proceedings, the presenter, or staff.
- c) In sessions which are limited as to the number of persons present, first priority will be given to the professional staff and excess space allotted to observers.
- d) Some inservices held in the school Division deal specifically with items such as teaching methods, strategies and techniques and are designed for more effective classroom instruction. These inservices do not deal with any specific curriculum and as a result would be unsuitable for parent attendance. The Superintendent of Schools will determine whether any or all of these sessions will be open to the public.
- e) Anyone not abiding by these guidelines will be asked to leave the premises.

Though Kelsey School Division welcomes parents, professional development days are designed specifically for teachers in order that they may enhance their teaching and thus provide a more beneficial education to the students.
