STUDENT WITHDRAWAL FROM SCHOOL

No parent, guardian, or other person is liable to any of the penalties of the School Attendance Act in respect of any child or any other person required by the Act to attend school regularly if the child has attained the full age of fifteen years and has obtained a School Leaving Certificate excusing attendance at school which is signed by:

- i) The parent, or guardian, or other person having legal charge or control of the child;
- ii) The school attendance officer;
- iii) The school principal;
- iv) The Superintendent for the school Division.(1)

A student 15 years of age may request a School Leaving Certificate. A student 15 years of age may be considered for a School Leaving Certificate when the request, with necessary background, is forwarded to the Superintendent by the principal. The final decision by the Superintendent will take into consideration the opinion of the parent and the principal, as well as that of the Attendance Officer of the Division.
