VISITORS TO THE SCHOOLS

All public visitors to the school should report directly to the principal or to the office. The principal or designate will give the visitors access to other areas of the school, or to staff members as the principal or designate deems appropriate.

Kelsey School Division Board of Trustees feels action should be taken against any person who willfully disturbs and interrupts a school activity. Therefore, any person who:

- a) is an agent or salesman who enters a particular school without the consent of the Superintendent, or
- b) willfully disturbs or interrupts the proceedings of a school or meeting held under the Public Schools Act, or
- c) willfully disturbs or interrupts any public school, or classroom, or classes of instruction being conducted within the school or disturbs the school by their action in that the school building or so close to the school building as to interrupt the proceedings:

shall be immediately requested to leave the premises and if failing to do so, shall be reported to the proper authorities with the request that forceable removal be applied.

These public visitors are not to be confused with school visitors who are defined in and referred to in Policy LJ

Public school visitors are:

- a) members of the advisory board, judges, social services personnel, and any such persons who, in the judgment of the Superintendent, provide a direct educational benefit to the child.
